### **The Job**

You are joining for year three of a three year project. Your eye will be on delivering the project objectives as envisioned at the commencement of the project. You will be self employed and part of a dynamic team.

### **Background**

One School One Planet is an EU funded 3 year project delivered through the Rural Development Partnership. We began in Sept 2016 and complete in September 2019.

We have based our central project theme on the Paris Climate Agreement and have argued that a transformation in education and community engagement will be essential to enable society to meet these ambitious targets.

The project is working with Llanfyllin High school to develop teaching materials and learning in how to link climate change and permaculture to the core curriculum. The project also recognises the importance of creating an overlap between education in school and wider community engagement. We aim to convert these broader concerns into useful practical action at a community level.

Sector39's mission statement is to bring permaculture education into new areas, we engage with individuals, community, schools, churches, international aid agencies, transition town groups and more to help spread permaculture education and project development. We want to develop a strong global perspective to our work and to link to universal themes of transformation and transition.

- Permaculture is about recognising and changing our relationship with the living environment we are part of.
- Understanding that the problems caused by people can also be solved by people.
- Permaculture is a different way of thinking and a key tool in facilitating the changes needed to be made in the transition to a low carbon, climate friendly economy.
